

**Grading Using +/- System**  
Spring, 2009

The University Senate approved the use of the A+ grade as part of the +/- grading system. There is no university-wide or college-wide policy on using the +/- system, but some units have policies governing the use of +/- grades, so check with your unit head. Courses will multiple sections should adopt the same grading system.

Suggested numerical range to use with letter grade and quality points:

| Letter Grade | Quality Points | Suggested Numerical Range* |
|--------------|----------------|----------------------------|
| A+           | 4.30           | 98-100                     |
| A            | 4.00           | 94-97.9                    |
| A-           | 3.70           | 90-93.9                    |
| B+           | 3.30           | 88-89.9                    |
| B            | 3.00           | 84-87.9                    |
| B-           | 2.70           | 80-83.9                    |
| C+           | 2.30           | 78-79.9                    |
| C            | 2.00           | 74-77.9                    |
| C-           | 1.70           | 70-73.9                    |
| D            | 1.00           | 65-69.9                    |
| F            | 0.00           | <65                        |
| WF           | 0.00           |                            |

\*Letter grade and quality points are university-wide standards (from undergraduate and graduate catalogs) but the numerical range is a suggestion from the CHHS Dean's Office. Faculty have the ability to assign a numerical range to letter grades but this information should be clearly identified in the course syllabus.
