The Division of Physical Therapy has 11 full-time tenure-track and non-tenure track faculty and several part-time faculty. The Division of Physical Therapy offers a Doctor of Physical Therapy degree. The individual in this position will be responsible for overseeing the general operation of the Division of Physical Therapy and will report to the Director of the School of Health Professions. - Ph.D (or Ed.D.) with eligibility for licensure as a Physical Therapist in the State of Georgia
- Academic credentials, including teaching and research experience, consistent with appointment at the Associate or Full Professor level
- Evidence of strong written and oral communication skills, and excellent interpersonal skills
- Convincing evidence of the ability to administer a program and faculty offering graduate degrees
