

# The Kaiser Permanente Bridge Program

## KEEPING COMMUNITIES HEALTHY



The Kaiser Permanente Bridge Program is uniquely designed to help those who are uninsured, income-eligible obtain health care coverage for a low monthly charge for up to 24 months. Eligible individuals pay a fraction of the premium cost and Kaiser Permanente subsidizes the rest. Coverage includes preventive services, hospitalization, comprehensive pharmacy and more.

### Eligibility Requirements

- At least one family member (subscriber, spouse or dependent) must be a student in the College of Health & Human Sciences at Georgia State University.
- Applicants and all dependents must live in Kaiser Permanente's metro Atlanta service area
- The annual household income must meet the Kaiser Permanente Bridge Program income guidelines
- Applicants cannot be eligible for any other health insurance program including Medicare, Medicaid, PeachCare or employer-sponsored health care (excluding COBRA)
- Must be age 64 and under
- Applicant may not have been previously enrolled in the Kaiser Permanente Bridge Program

### Verification Requirements

- Proof of Identity
- Proof of Residence
- Proof of Income
