

Registration for N7920 / N7930 General Information and Procedures

Credit Hour Requirement:

FNP, CNS-Psych, WMH, PNP students: 1 credit hour

AHN CNS students: 2 credit hours

Preliminary Registration Requirements:

Approval for registration requires completion of either the N7920 Course Form or the N7930 Course Form and the signature of the **FACULTY MEMBER WHO WILL BE DIRECTLY SUPERVISING THE PROJECT. For each subsequent semester the student wishes to register, the form is to be redated and resigned. Substantive changes in the project requires the submission of a new Course Form.**

The Graduate Administrative Coordinator cannot authorize students for registration without the name of the faculty member and signature indicating agreement to supervise the project.

Tracking Procedures:

Four copies of the N7920 or the N7930 Course Form are to be made:

1 for the student to retain

1 for the student's file

1 for the supervising faculty

1 for the Graduate Administrative Coordinator

The Graduate Administrative Coordinator will maintain a N7920/N7930 folder containing a master list of student/faculty names and copies of the N7920 and the N7930 Course Forms for all students taking either N7920 or N7930. A new list and Course Form copies are made for every semester.

The student/faculty list is to be distributed each semester to the faculty currently supervising students and to the Associate Director for Graduate Programs.

Course Grade:

Course grade is to be an S, U, or an IP.

A grade of S AND 4 copies (APA style) of the project must be received in order for the student to graduate.

NOTE: Additional copies will be required for each student's file if more than one student is participating in the project.

Completed Projects:

The four copies of the project are distributed to the supervising faculty (1 copy), Director for Graduate Programs (1 copy), and the Graduate Administrative Coordinator (2 copies) who will maintain 1 copy in the R & I Office and place the second copy in the student's file. The cover page should indicate the student name(s), supervising faculty, and the date of completion.

NOTE: Additional copies will be required for each student's file if more than one student is participating in the project.
